

What Can I Recycle?

Green Waste

- **Yard waste** including grass clippings, leaves, twigs and branches, logs and stumps up to 24" in diameter and 6 feet long.
- Please remove plastic bags!
- Consider the **earth-friendly option** of using a mulching lawn mower—it saves time, water and fertilizer!

Plastics

- **#1—#7 plastics** with screw-top lids only.
- Please rinse before recycling, and remove labels if easy to remove.

Cans

- **Aluminum cans** of all types—soda, beer, juice (beverage cans only).
- **Food cans** of all types—tin or steel.
- Please rinse before recycling, and remove labels if easy to remove.

Glass

- **All food jars and drink bottles**, regardless of color.
- Please rinse before recycling, and separate lids into metals recycling bin.

Paper Products

- **Corrugated cardboard.**
- **Office paper** in earth tones only, with window film removed from envelopes.
- **Newspaper, catalogs, magazines, softcover books, and hardback books** with covers removed.
- **Paperboard**, including cereal boxes, shoe boxes and egg cartons.
- The City of Sheridan is currently **NOT** recycling waxed boxes such as milk cartons.

What Can I Recycle?

Scrap Metal

- **Heavy metal** including engine blocks, mowers, farm equipment, cars, tire rims with tire removed.
- Remove all fluids, oil, anti-freeze, etc.
- **Air conditioners, refrigerators and freezers**; must be decommissioned by a certified technician, or City will decommission for a \$25 fee.

Tires

- **Passenger and light truck tires** only; must be removed from the rim and taken to the landfill. Fee of \$100 per ton—approximately \$2 per average tire.

Oil

- **All residential motor oil** accepted free of charge at landfill— up to 5 gallons per visit per customer.

Hazardous Waste

- **Drain cleaners, cleaners, insecticides, floor stripper, floor wax, yard chemicals, fertilizers and paint.**
- Please do not dispose of any of the above in regular trash! Accepted only on specially advertised hazardous materials days.

E-Waste

- **All residential computers, monitors, printers, televisions, etc.** accepted at landfill free of charge.

Medical Waste

- Accepted at landfill on Wednesdays. Sharps should be in sharps containers or a labeled bag.
- No charge for residential customers.

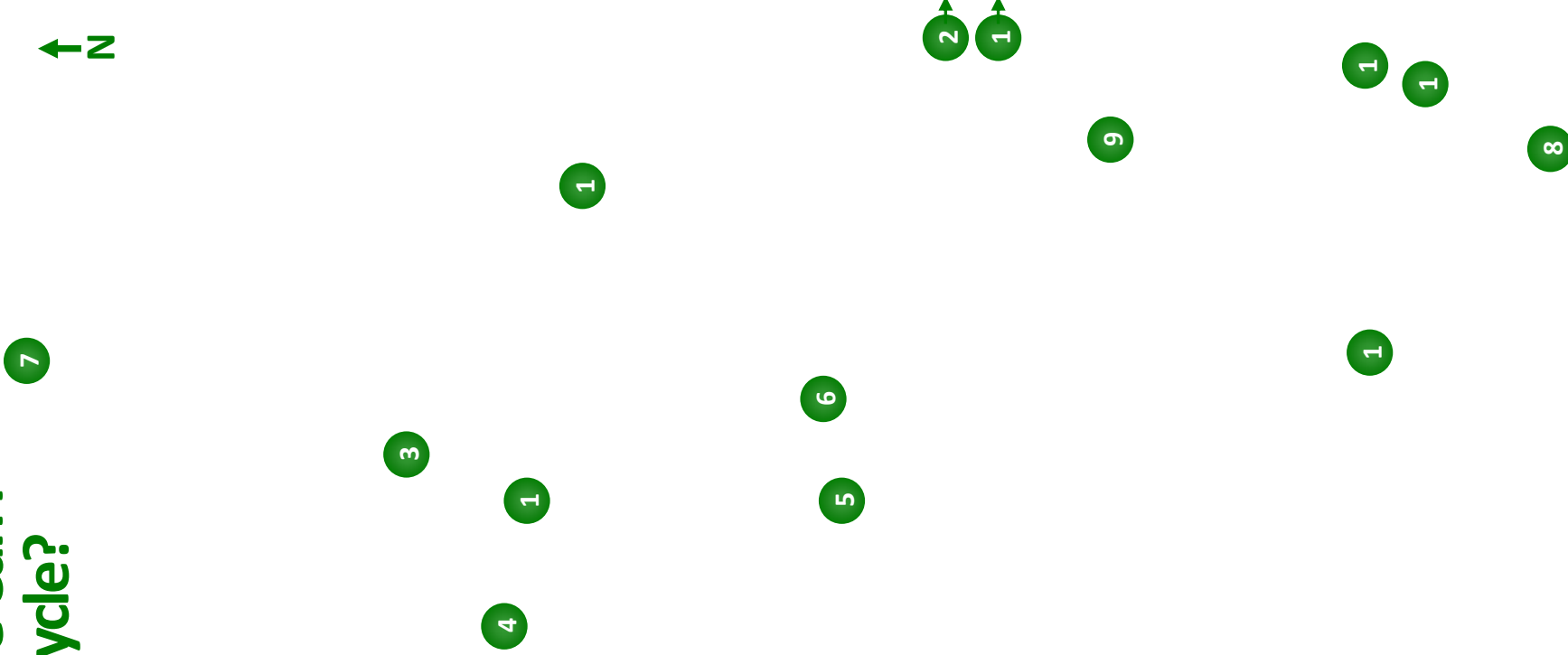

One-Stop Drop Sites

(Cardboard, paperboard, newspaper, office paper, magazines, aluminum/tin cans, plastic, glass and green waste)

1. **City Landfill**
(83 East Ridge Road)
2. **City Recycling Center**
(1148 KROE Lane) *No green waste*
3. **Skate Park parking area**
(adjacent to Thorne-Rider Park off 11th Street and Dana Avenue)
4. **5th & Highland**
(1261 Highland Avenue)
5. **Kendrick Park**
(south side between Bellevue and Swan Streets)
6. **Sheridan Senior Center**
(211 Smith Street) *No green waste*
7. **K-Mart**
(2571 N. Main Street)
8. **Behind Wash Yer Wooleys**
(on East Brundage Lane across from T&C Liquors) *No green waste*
9. **Washington Park**
(On Coffeen Avenue next to Holiday Lodge)

Green Waste Only Sites

10. **Oatts Memorial Park**
(on 7th Street between Sheridan Avenue and Saberton)
11. **Marshall Park**
(on Big Horn Avenue at Edwards Drive)
12. **Mavrakis Pond**
(on 8th Street near Dana Avenue)
Available seasonally
